Statement of Beliefs

Wellspring Homeschool Community is a Christian-run organization that looks to God to lead and guide as our community grows. All members of our group must agree to abide by certain principals during our meeting times. Those principals include the following:

- There is one and only one living and true God. The eternal triune God reveals Himself to us as Father, Son, and Holy Spirit, with distinct personal attributes, but without division of nature, essence, or being.
- Man is the special creation of God, made in His own image.
- God created them male and female as the crowning work of His creation. The gift of gender is thus part of the goodness of God's creation. The sacredness of human personality is evident in that God created man in His own image.
- God has ordained the family as the foundational institution of human society. It is composed of persons related to one another by marriage, blood, or adoption. Marriage is the uniting of one man and one woman in covenant commitment for a lifetime.
- Salvation involves the redemption of the whole man, and is offered freely to all who accept Jesus Christ as Lord and Saviour, who by His own blood obtained eternal redemption for the believer. There is no salvation apart from personal faith in Jesus Christ as Lord.
- Every person of every race possesses full dignity and is worthy of respect and Christian love.
- The Bible affirms the duty of parents to educate their children. All classes at Wellspring will be based on Christ as the chief cornerstone and God as creator of our world and universe. However, we are non-denominational in focus and will not teach any specific doctrine.

We do not limit our membership to those who hold to the same beliefs, nor is it our goal to force these beliefs on others. We ask that, while attending Wellspring functions, participants be respectful of the above positions in behavior, speech, and dress.
